The Work consists of new network equipment and telephone system.

A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting between prospective bidders and the Architect

Bidders are urged to attend.

A bid bond for five percent (5%) of the base bid cost is required
and must accompany each proposal.

Bids must be held firm for one hundred twenty (120) days beyond the bid opening date.

The successful bidder must file a one hundred percent (100%) Performance Bond,
a one hundred percent (100%) Labor & Materials Bond and a Certificate of Insurance
with the Finance Officer within ten (10) days of notice of bid award.

Plans and specifications must be obtained directly from The Color Company,
85 Willow Street, New Haven (Tel 203-624-0440) at a cost to the Contractor.

In accordance with Connecticut General Statute Sections 4a-100 and 4b-91, a responsible bid must contain
two (2) documents: The Contractor Prequalification Certificate and the Update (Bid) Statement. The
classification TELECOMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS is required as a minimum, for each bid package.

The Town of Ellington reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities, omissions,
excess verbiage or technical defects in the bidding and the Town need not necessarily award the contract
to the lowest Bidder if, in the opinion of the Town, it would be in the best interest of the Town of
Ellington to accept another bid
