**Pursuant to Substitute House Bill No. 5180 "AN ACT CONCERNING CONCRETE FOUNDATIONS"**

Section 2 of this legislation states: *Any owner of a residential building who has obtained a written evaluation from a professional engineer licensed pursuant to Chapter 391 of the General Statutes indication that the foundation of such residential building was made with defective concrete may provide a copy of such evaluation to the assessor and request a reassessment of the residential by the assessor.*

You must submit the required evaluation report performed by a professional engineer licensed pursuant to Chapter 391 of the General Statutes. I hereby declare under penalty of perjury that the information contained on this application is true according to the best of my knowledge, belief and understanding.
