

Some Items to be placed in Recycling Cart:

Picked-up *every other week*

- ◆ newspaper/magazines/catalogs
- ◆ corrugated cardboard – place loose in cart, flatten and cut boxes to fit into cart
- ◆ boxboard (food and cereal boxes, shoe boxes)
- ◆ office paper/junk mail
- ◆ glass food and beverage containers – rinsed clean,
- ◆ metal food and beverage containers – rinsed clean
- ◆ aluminum foil and trays
- ◆ plastic food and beverage containers - rinsed clean
- ◆ milk cartons/juice boxes – rinsed clean

Material Not Accepted

- ◆ plastic bags and plastic wrap
- ◆ Food-contaminated items
- ◆ motor oil or anti-freeze bottles
- ◆ window glass, auto glass, drinking glasses
- ◆ pots and pans, dishes, Pyrex, ceramics
- ◆ flower pots
- ◆ styrofoam
- ◆ paint cans
- ◆ containers that held hazardous materials

- ◆ waste oil, antifreeze
- ◆ vehicle batteries
- ◆ textiles
- ◆ propane tanks - 5 lbs. & 20 lbs.
- ◆ televisions and electronics
- ◆ computer components
- ◆ fluorescent light bulbs

Weekend Hours - First and Third Saturday

April through November - 9 am to 12 pm.

The shed will also open Saturday, January 5 and
Saturday, January 12 from 9 am to 12 pm.

Bulky Waste

Scrap metal, appliances, tools, water tanks, faucets, tires, rims, toys, toilets, sinks, mattresses, box springs, etc. Wood and carpet cannot exceed 4 feet in length. Carpet should be rolled and tied. No more than 2 cubic yards of bulky waste allowed per week. To schedule a pickup, call

Some Accepted Materials: mercury thermometers and thermostats, dry cleaning fluid, fluorescent bulbs, arts and crafts supplies, rechargeable batteries, general purpose cleaners, aerosol cans with hazardous content, drain cleaners, metal polishers, floor cleaners, oven cleaners, wax and polishes, tile cleaners, toilet cleaners, gasoline, fire starters, engine/radiator flushes, chemistry kits, paints, rust preventative, wood preservative, lead based paint, solvents, degreasers, wood strippers, paint thinner, fertilizers with pesticides and herbicides, muriatic acid, insect spray, pool chemicals, etc.

Materials Not Accepted: Medications, asbestos, explosives, fireworks, and ammunition.

Note: Leftover latex paint may also be disposed of in your regular household trash. First harden or dry it by removing the lid and placing the can in a safe, well-ventilated area.
