This report reflects the emergency response and training activity for the Crystal Lake Fire Department Inc. for January 1 - March 31, 2018.

The Crystal Lake Fire Department Responded to 70 emergency calls for service during this time period totaling 959 hours of emergency scene operations.

During this time period the members trained on numerous aspects of emergency response totaling an additional 776 hours of training time covering the following subjects.

- Fire Suppression
- Rapid Intervention Teams
- Pump Operations
- Engine 142 In Service Training
- New SCBA MSA G1 In Service Training
- Cold Water Rescue
- Ice Dive Operations
- Incident Safety Officer: Fire Suppression Certification
- EMT Initial Certification
- EMT and EMR Recertification
- EMS standard of care

The Fire Officers of the Crystal Lake Fire Department also completed 2,222 hours of Administrative and Duty Hours to complete required administrative tasks and ensuring proper coverage of our service area.
