

Kimball Trail Trail Guide



The Kimball Forest Trail is located on Town of Ellington land between Hopkins Road and Crystal Lake Road (CT Rte 140). The trail heads southwest along a mountain laurel patch descending to Kimball Brook. After crossing Kimball Brook, the trail winds east along the banks of the brook with several small babbling water cascades. At the next bridge you can cross the brook and continue on the White Trail Loop going northwest back to the kiosk and parking or go east following the Peach Trail through a field of rocks to the third and fourth bridge crossings. The trail continues up a steep embankment going north to Hopkins Road. Along Hopkins Road, you can access to the Blue Shenipsit Trail. Current trail length is just under a mile.
